Guidelines for the 2nd exam

Date and Location

• The 2nd exam will take place:

Thu 10.10., from 12:00 to 02:00 PM s.t., in room M 218, Geschwister-Scholl-Platz 1, Munich.

- Please be there on time and look up the schedule of public transportation systems to be aware of any delays. When the final exam will have started, we are not allowed to let you in if you are too late.
- You have 90 minutes for the exam.

Identity number

Please bring with you your identity card (driver licence or passport are also fine) and your current student identity card or a valid certificate of matriculation.

According to a law passed by the Bayerischer Landtag, effective from Aug. 1st 2017, it is forbidden to wear a full face veil at universities. Based on this law students wearing a full face veil are not allowed to participate at the exam.

Material and auxiliarly means

- You do not need to learn all formulas, however simple formulas that can be derived by understanding the problem are expected to be known (e.g. Levensthein).
- The only auxiliaries that are allowed are (triangle) ruler and a non-programmable pocket calculator. No other auxiliary materials are allowed. This includes books, lecture slides, notes, own sheets, mobile devices, smartwatches, laptops, tablets, etc.). In case of violation you will fail the exam.
- Mobile devices should be turned off! In particular, you are not allowed to use your mobile devices as calculator.
- We will provide additional sheets if you need some.
- Please use a pen writing in black or blue. Not allowed are colors red and green (these are reserved for correction). Please don't use a pencil since it is not permanent and therefore invalid for answers. You might also bring a ruler and a second pen writing in a different color.

Organization

- The exam will start at 12:00 s.t. If you are not present on time, you are not allowed to participate in the test.
- Please write down your name and your matriculation number on the first cover sheet! We will collect the first cover sheets when we check your IDs. If your exam comes apart it is crucial that the solutions can be assigned to you.
- You cannot hand us your test in the first and last 15 minutes of the exam. (In the first 15 minutes, we've got to check your identity number and we also don't want to bother anyone in the last 15 minutes. Please pay respect to other participants.)
- At the end of the exam, please stay at your place till we received ALL exams and then start to pack your things up.
